MAGIC CAMP CODE OF CONDUCT – GOALIES

1. Have FUN!
2. Work hard – give 100% each day
3. Be positive
4. Respect your Instructors / Mentors / Staff
5. Respect the other Goalies at Camp
6. Be on time and follow your schedule
7. Do not leave the group at any time.
8. NO fooling around at anytime during the camp. Any misconduct that is not respectful to others – will bring a caution and if continues could lead to being barred from the camp.
9. If you must leave for any reason please inform any of the Instructors and have your parents confirm, you will only be released to a parent or guardian.
10. Ask questions

All goalies must be ready (fully dressed) to go on the ice 5 minutes before each session. After each session, goalies should get undressed quickly, hang up their equipment and wait for instructor to take you to next activity. If you need assistance getting dressed, please let our staff/instructors know, so they can help you out!

ON-ICE THEORY SESSIONS FORMAT

The on-ice theory sessions are designed to introduce new skills and concepts to the participants.

Don't Stand Around! Goaltenders will have time when they are not involved at the station and will be guided by our mentors/instructors.

Take this opportunity to work on your weaker skills in the practice areas to the sides.

If a goalie has any questions, he/she should feel free to approach the instructor or head instructor for help.

These sessions will vary from day to day to coincide with on-ice sessions. Bring running shoes, shorts. Remember drink plenty of water during the camp.
